

Have you ever knelt before the crucifix and prayed to the Lord to embrace you in a loving and healing embrace? I have. "Take me in your embrace, Lord," I cry out. Then I cry out, "No, Jesus, do not hug me on the Cross, but with your Resurrected body." - 3. Place our complete trust in Jesus;
- 4. Go to confession, preferably before that Sunday;
- 5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast;
- 6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy;
- 7. Be merciful to others, through our actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy. ... I demand from you deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse or absolve yourself from it" (Diary of St. Faustina, 742).
