Isaiah 7:10-14; Romans 1:1-7; Matthew 1:18-24

The child whose birth we celebrate at Christmas is:

A child "who was descended from David according to the flesh" We must never forget that God acts through human beings to fulfil His purpose. The story of Christmas, therefore, is not just the story about God and Jesus but also the story about Mary and Joseph, about the shepherds and the magi, the story of how human beings cooperate with God.

A child whom God Himself declared to be God's beloved Son especially by raising him from the dead. He is the one who speaks God's word, the one to whom we must listen.

A child through whom we receive grace G-R-A-C-E stands for God's Riches At Christ's Expense. "The law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17). This is the child through whom we receive God's abundant blessings much more than we ever deserve.

A child through whom we receive our apostleship, that is, our calling as God's servants. In Jesus we receive divine riches and privileges (grace), but we also receive a divine calling to serve God in our neighbor (apostleship).
