

Living Our Mission Update

In 2014, the Diocese of Richmond initiated a 5 year fundraising campaign called "Living Our Mission". We received a share of the funds contributed by our parishioners. As a part of this process, Saint Mary of the Annunciation

had to designate how the funds would be used for our parish. Our goal was to establishing a Free-Standing Space to Accommodate Our Food Pantry, a Nursery, and Adult Education. As a result, our Living Our Mission fund has over \$75,000 to achieve this goal. Father Muddu, the Pastoral Council and Finance Council are working together to explore ways to achieve the Living Our Mission goal.


