### Living Our Mission Update



In 2014, the Diocese of Richmond initiated a 5 year fundraising campaign called “Living Our Mission”. We received a share of the funds contributed by our parishioners. As a part of this process, Saint Mary of the Annunciation had to designate how the funds would be used for our parish. Our goal was to establishing a Free-Standing Space to Accommodate Our Food Pantry, a Nursery, and Adult Education. As a result, our Living Our Mission fund has over \$75,000 to achieve this goal. Father Muddu, the Pastoral Council and Finance Council are working together to explore ways to achieve the Living Our Mission goal.

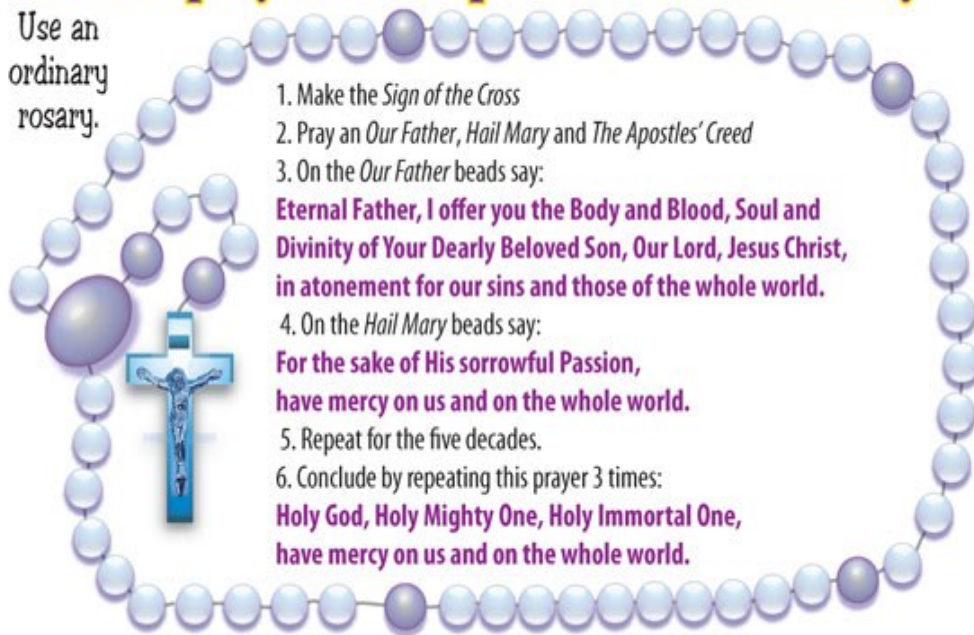

# How to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Use an ordinary rosary.



1. Make the Sign of the Cross
2. Pray an *Our Father*, *Hail Mary* and *The Apostles' Creed*
3. On the *Our Father* beads say:  
**Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.**
4. On the *Hail Mary* beads say:  
**For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.**
5. Repeat for the five decades.
6. Conclude by repeating this prayer 3 times:  
**Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.**
