The Solemnity of the Assumption is, in some ways, the paramount feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary, since it commemorates her passing, body and soul, into the glory of Heaven. Though the dogma of the Assumption was only defined in 1950, it was widely believed by the earliest Christians. Given her Immaculate Conception, the grave was no place for her body.
