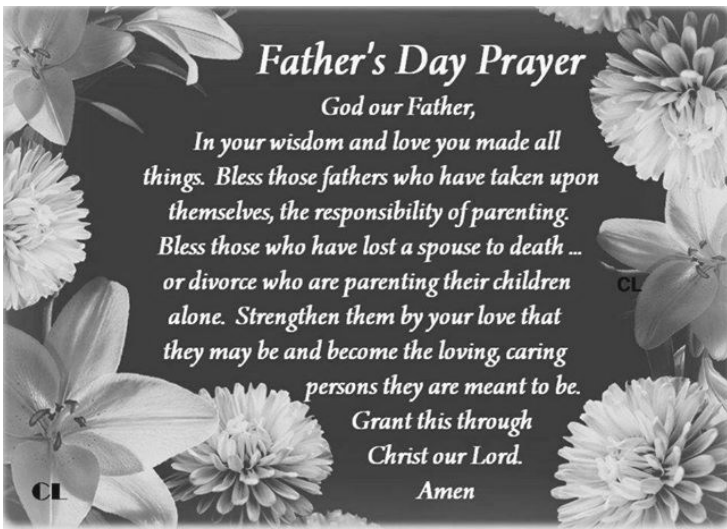
STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

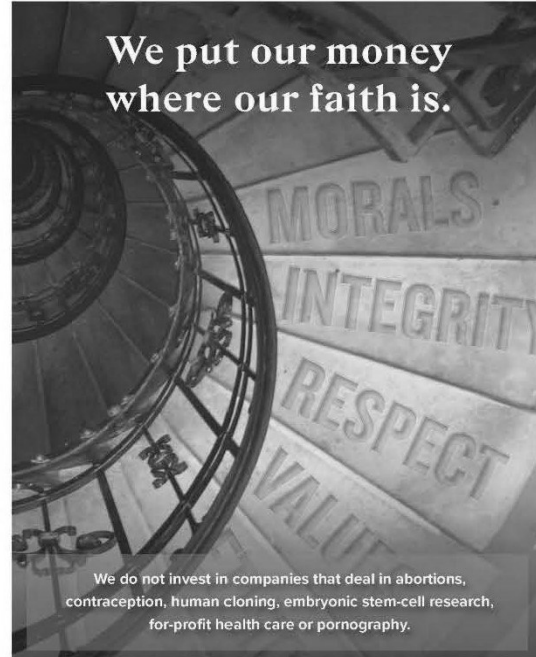
