### WORLD MISSION SUNDAY IS TODAY

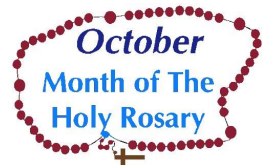

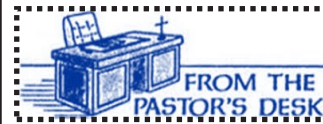
