#### UPDATE ON THE FREE-STANDING BUILDING

With the assistance of the Director of Real Estate from the Diocese of Richmond, we are taking the necessary steps to get the new building that will be used for the Food Pantry and additional classrooms underway. Many tests will need to be conducted, such as electrical, sanitary, mechanical, etc., and a civil plan completed before we can move to the construction phase of the project.

The building may exceed the \$400,000 construction budget as currently conceptualized, so we will need to modify our plans as necessary. More will be known in this regard as more detailed plans are drawn up. With the involvement of the Diocesan Building and Architectural Review Committee (BARC), we will get the needed guidance for the funding process of a short-term loan for the project, if required.

Century Construction Company will act as the contracted preconstruction services project manager but the parish will be free to solicit several bids from various general contractors without being solely obligated to Century Construction. They will provide the parish with a detailed proposal soon that outlines their preconstruction services.

#### VIRTUS ADMINISTRATOR

What is VIRTUS? VIRTUS focuses on educating teachers, parents, volunteers and other adults who interact with children about sexual abuse and providing them with information to help prevent abuse.

We are looking for a VIRTUS Administrator for our church. The Administrator will oversee training and monitor ongoing compliance through the VIRTUS database. The Administrator is responsible for background checks and periodically checks the database to verify all volunteers complete the monthly online training bulletins. All training can be done online.
