Dear Parishioners,

As our maintenance committee continues to diligently evaluate the infrastructure needs of our church building, the recommendation came to me to act immediately to remediate and restore portions the exterior of the church building. Large sections of the external walls have begun to rot and require us to act quickly to prevent further damage. Therefore, after a bidding process, we have hired a contractor to evaluate, repair, and replace the problematic sections of the exterior wall. The funds for this repair are not being taken from the capital campaign, but rather, from our standard maintenance funds, which will cover the cost of the repairs. Our finance and maintenance committees are working closely together to ensure our regular maintenance funds are replenished over time through our weekly offerings.

Below are some photos of the problematic spots and the repairs that were conducted.
